Customize your Glucose Alarms

The FreeStyle Libre 3 system has optional, real-time glucose alarms[§] to alert you when your glucose is high or low.

The FreeStyle Libre 3 system includes the FreeStyle Libre 3 Plus sensor, FreeStyle Libre 3 sensor, Libre 3 app, and the FreeStyle Libre 3 reader.

You cannot use both the FreeStyle Libre 3 reader and the Libre app to scan the same FreeStyle Libre 3 Plus sensor for glucose readings. If you start the sensor with the app, then you cannot use the reader to scan for glucose readings and if you start the sensor with the reader, then you cannot use the app to scan for glucose readings. Whichever device you start the sensor with will receive alarms.

Please check the Support section of our website for more information about device compatibility before using the apps. Use of the FreeStyle Libre systems apps may require registration with LibreView. Fingersticks are required for treatment decisions when you see Check Blood Glucose symbol and when your glucose alarms and readings from the system do not match symptoms or expectations.
